Why Work at Erith School?

We are a larger than average co-education Secondary Modern School based in the northern sector of Bexley London Borough. We have approximately 2,000 students including just under 300 studying in the Sixth Form.

We are renowned for being a happy and vibrant school that has a reputation for developing excellent professional relationships between staff, students and their parents which is why many of our staff have remained with us for very many years.

There are huge opportunities for professional support and career development at Erith and many of our talented enthusiastic staff often find themselves being promoted onto TLR's within a few years of their appointments with us. We value our staff very highly and like to think of them more as friends and colleagues rather than a commodity.

The school itself is located on its own 25 acre site a five minute walk from Northumberland Heath Broadway where there are the usual High Street amenities. Bexleyheath Shopping Centre and Erith Town Centre are about a mile away in opposite directions where there are a greater range of shops and facilities.

Housing in Bexley is very affordable with many of the homes built between 1940 and 1960 in residential settings that are well maintained to a high standard. Like many other outer London Boroughs, there is an extensive building development programme to provide new homes on many of the brown field sites available in Bexley.

Transport links in the Borough are first class. Bexley has three different main railway lines running through it that connect commuters from Kent into the main line stations of London Victoria, London Bridge, Charing Cross and Cannon Street in less than 30 minutes. Erith School is situated conveniently to two of these train lines that can be reached by a twenty minute walk or a five minute car ride. Both these lines connect to the Dockland Light Railway and one will also eventually link directly to the Cross Rail terminus at Abbey Wood when it has been completed.

If travelling by car, the school has on-site parking as well as off road parking and is a six minute drive from the Dartford crossing; 5 minutes from the A2 which also provides easy access to the Kent Coast or Central London. We are 20 minutes from Greenwich Park with the Observatory, the Queens House and the Cutty Sark; and 10 minutes from Danson Park, Lessness Abbey and Hall Place. The Blue Water Shopping Centre is a 20 minutes car drive as are the principle towns of Dartford and Gravesend.

Erith School has some impressive examination outcomes and currently we are the second highest performing Secondary Modern School in the Borough. Over the last four years we have enjoyed a 98% pass rate at A 'level with many of our talented young people moving into studying at the University of their choice when they leave us.
